Top Tips

1. Don't waste your time!

- Do your research
- Read all the information made available to you ie application guidelines and FAQs
- Check their website for previous work they have funded
- Input vs Output Is applying worth your time?
- Determine whether or not your ask is realistic enough
- Are there any webinars/info sessions that you can attend?



2. Pitch Perfect

- Your application is an opportunity to persuade the reader
- Master your elevator pitch Who, What, When, How?
- Demonstrate impact through numbers
- Practice your pitch on someone outside of your organization. Do they understand what you do?



3. Solutions, not just the problem

- Think beyond the problem
- Talk about what you do and how you do it well
- Provide case studies highlighting your abilities as an organization



4. Know your finances

- Do the numbers in your application match those in your accounts?
- Do you understand your accounts?
- Are you confident enough to explain your accounts?
- Are you providing good value for money?
- Are your accounts up to date on the Charity Commission/Companies House websites?



5. Online presence

- Funders will do their research on you!
- Are your social media accounts and website up to date?
- Are all your records with Charity Commission or equivalent up to date?
