The Head of Operations ensures UK Youth runs efficiently, compliantly, and with impact. Reporting to the Director of Finance and Operations and working closely with Assistant Directors, the role drives core operations, systems improvement, performance reporting, and policy oversight.

Overseeing IT, CRM, project delivery, governance, and administration, the postholder also coleads the development of an Organisation Performance Dashboard with the Finance Director to track KPIs and inform decision-making.

- Ensure that key operational and strategic KPIs are tracked effectively and support datadriven decision-making across teams.
- Foster a culture of data-informed practice, supporting teams in understanding and using performance insights to improve outcomes.

Annual Planning Support

- Support the coordination and delivery of the organisation's annual business planning process.
- Work closely with the Finance team to ensure strategic plans are aligned with budget setting and financial projections.
- Help teams across the organisation develop clear, actionable plans that align with UK Youth's long-term goals.

- Ensure all systems are user-friendly, support hybrid working, and meet organisational needs.
- Oversee the maintenance of robust cybersecurity practices, including Cyber Essentials Accreditation.
