Young people face increasing challenges to their mental health, safety and future prospects. **Yet since 2010, local authority spending on youth services has fallen by 73**% in England, forcing half of youth centres to close and the loss of a third of the workforce.

Evidence shows: Youth work is not a luxury – it's essential. It helps empower young people to thrive and contribute at every stage of their lives.
